## PADDLE AND HIKE YOUR WAY THROUGH A LEARNING ADVENTURE

An exciting environmental adventure for middle school children is returning to Niagara Falls. It's free, safe, and fun. **Honeywell Adventures in Environmental Leadership**, co-sponsored by **Honeywell** and **The OSC Charitable Foundation**, is a programming partnership with **Buffalo Niagara Riverkeeper** and **Niagara Falls Housing Authority** that will teach children about the watershed and wildlife through interactive, hands-on curriculum. Students will learn how to paddle kayaks from certified Riverkeeper instructors and go on bird watching hikes led by experts from the Buffalo Audubon Society.
